From Jesus's entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, we then have Holy Week Reflections for half an hour each evening at 7pm (Monday - Wednesday), and a service of Holy Communion on Maundy Thursday at 7pm. Then on Good Friday we have Messy Easter at 10am (a family friendly event with crafts, games, refreshments, songs and a short talk) and we mark the Last Hour at the Cross at 2pm (a quiet, reflective service). Finally, on Easter Day we gather to celebrate the amazing good news that Jesus is alive, with an All Age Easter Communion service at 10.30am (and don't forget that the clocks go forward in the early hours of Easter Day). Please do join us for breakfast before this service (bacon or sausage baps or a vegetarian alternative) - sign up on the sheet at the back of church so we have an idea of numbers.
